The Committee scrutinized each case, obtained explanations from the concerned students, and considered all relevant records and evidence. Based on the recommendations of the Committee, appropriate action was taken in accordance with the University Examination Regulations, and all the cases were successfully resolved. (Annexure - 11)
